

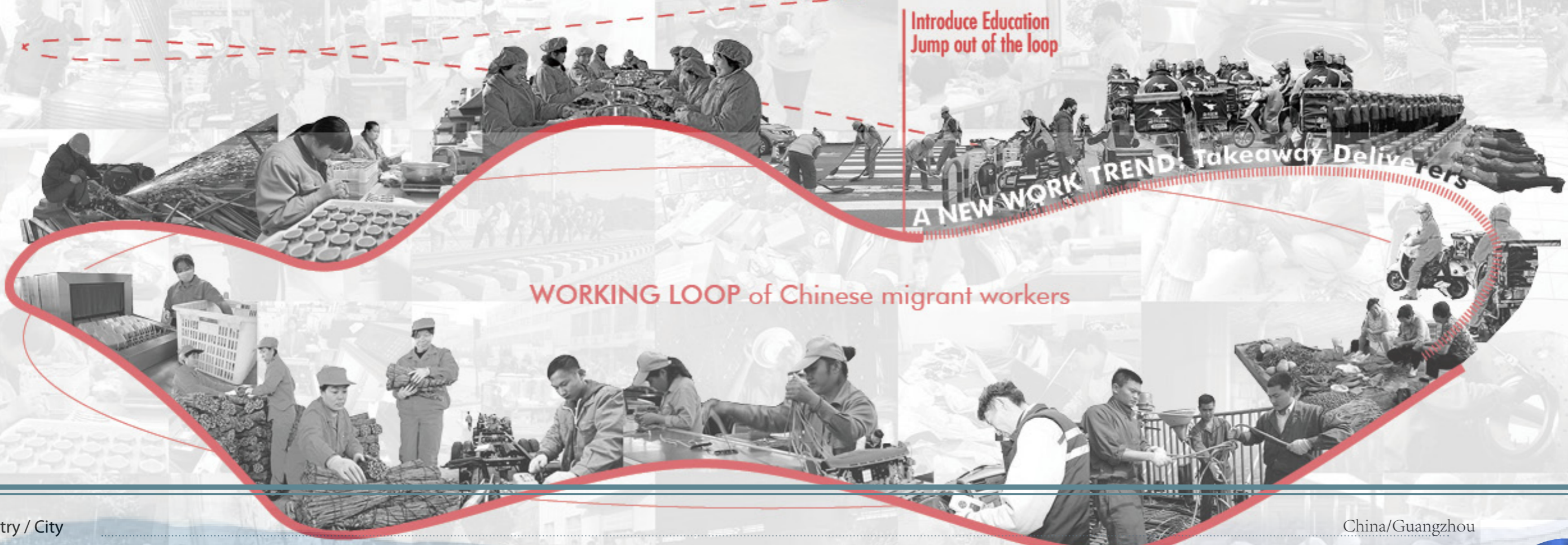
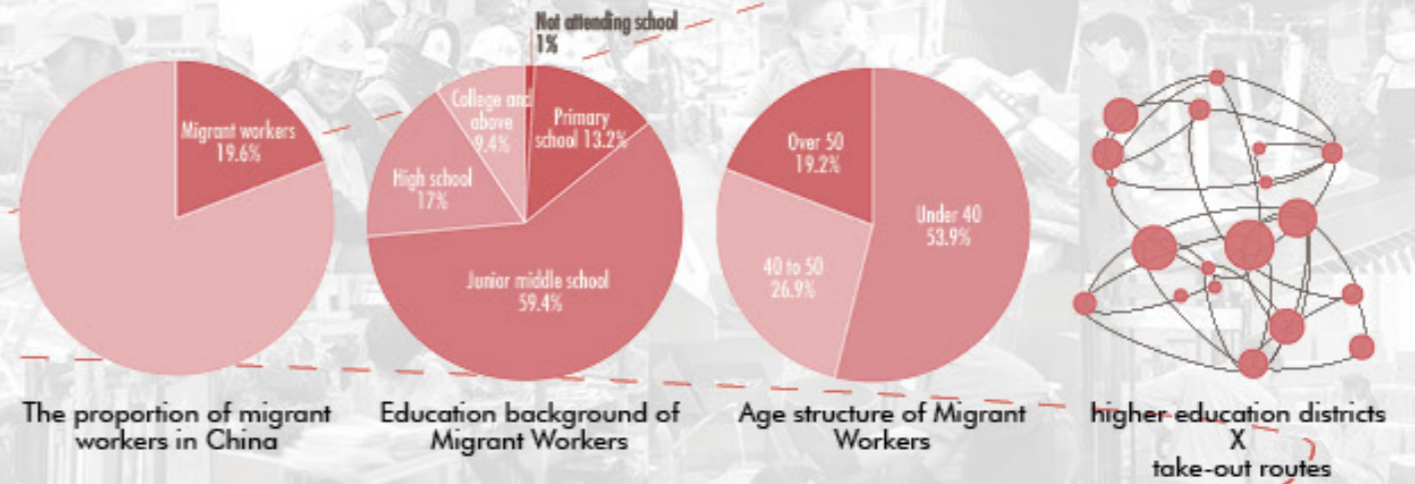
# CURRENT SITUATION OF CHINESE MIGRANT WORKERS



In China, the total number of migrant workers in 2018 reached 288.36 billion, mainly young and middle-aged, with more than half of the education level in junior high school and below, with an average monthly income of 3,275 yuan per person. The new-generation migrant workers has gradually become the main force of rural migrant workers. They are defined as "new urban youth".

Because of their low education level, Chinese migrant workers often face the dilemma that once lose their jobs, it will be difficult to restart, and fall into a vicious circle of jumping from a low-income job to another, such as the 1998 laid-off national event.

In recent years, the takeout industry has developed rapidly, and the number of takeout deliverers has exceeded 7 million, which has become one of the first choices for new urban youth. But they are also facing the crisis of being replaced by artificial intelligence. Where will these takeouts go in the future? Will they enter a vicious circle like laid-off workers?

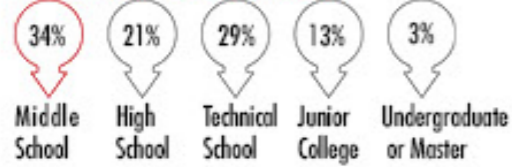

**LEVEL OF EDUCATION**

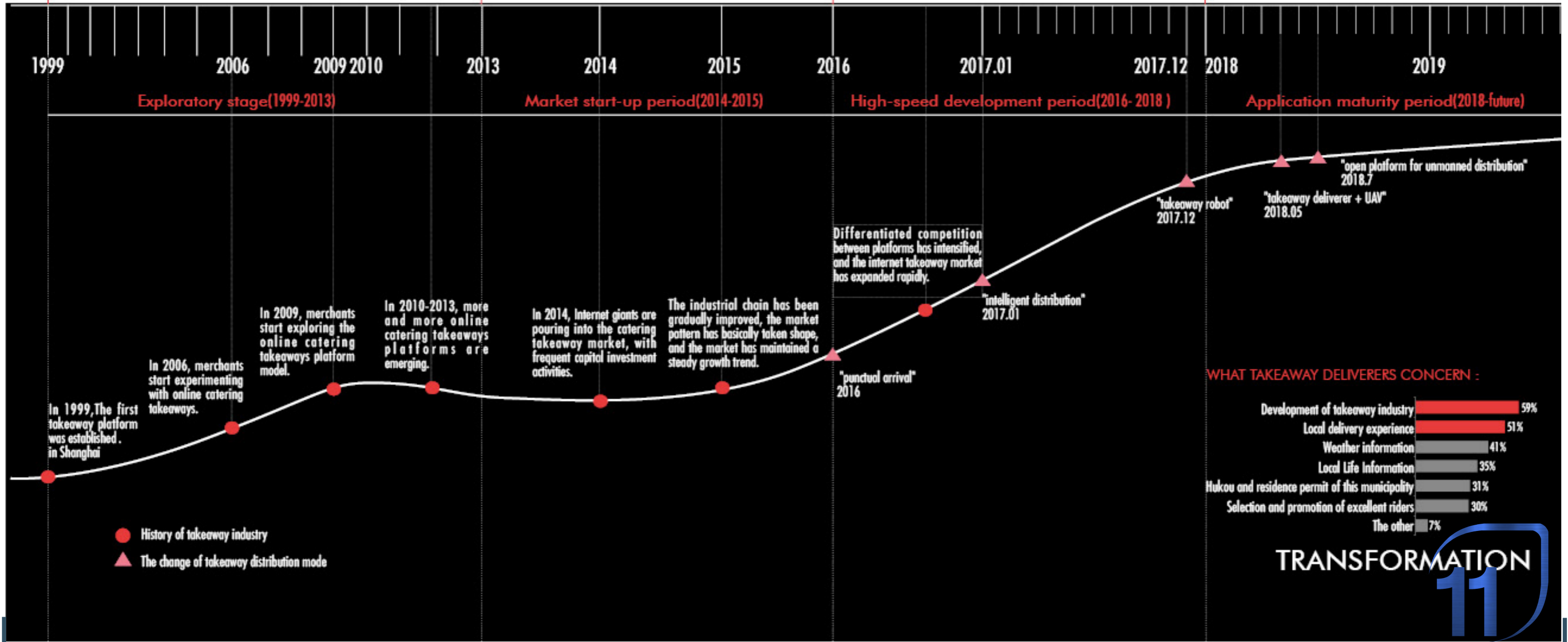


**STAGE1:**With the popularity of the internet, online catering takeaway began to appear, merchants began to try to sell takeaways through online sales channels.

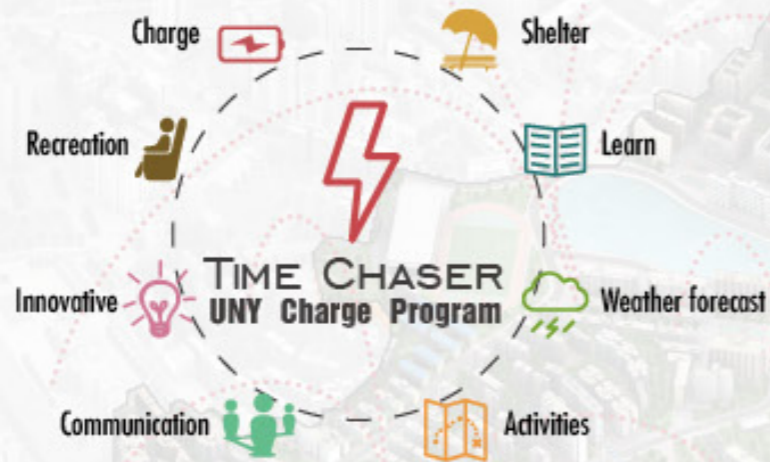

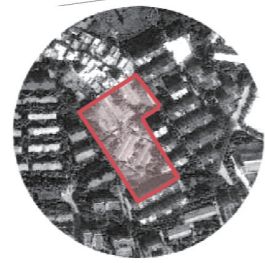
