



FLOOD IN PRESIDENTA'S CREEK




As the stream is channeled in the upper parts of the basin and the soil is waterproofed for a large part of its route, the water travels with great speed and the accumulation of the flow occurs in the lower part of the neighborhood that corresponds to the old valley Medellín river producing large floods and damage to many buildings.

GRAPHIC OF ACCESIBILITY IN PRESIDENT'S CREEK




CLOSED PUBLIC AREAS AND FENCES


