## The 12th Rosa Barba Casanovas International Landscape Architecture Prize reveals its 11 finalist landscape architecture projects

• The winning project will be announced within the framework of the 12th Barcelona International Landscape Architecture Biennial on November 24-28.

Barcelona, July 10, 2023.- The <u>international jury</u> of the <u>Rosa Barba Casanovas International Landscape Architecture Prize</u> has made public the eleven finalist projects and 225 selected from this year's edition of this prestigious contest that highlights the most recent initiatives in landscape architecture from around the world in the last five years (2017-2022).

The authors of the eleven finalist projects will present their projects within the framework of the Symposium of the 12th International Landscape Architecture Biennial, in a session scheduled for November 27, 2023. A grand prize of 15,000 euros will be awarded to the winning project.
